



Conductive Group selected for prestigious Nunn-Perry Award

The Conductive Group has been selected for the highly competitive and prestigious Nunn-Perry Award, which recognizes excellence in the US Department of Defense (DoD) Mentor Protégé Program. Named for the critical contributions of Senator Sam Nunn and Former Secretary of Defense William Perry, recipients of the Nunn-Perry Award excel in technical assistance, protégé growth, and impact on protégé development. The Mentor Protégé Program (MPP) was established in response to concerns raised by DoD contractors regarding their inability to meet Small Business subcontracting goals. Today, MPP participants deliver capabilities across major defense programs in support of the Warfighter.

The Conductive Group (CG) partnered with Montana State University and their MilTech program (MSU-MilTech) in order to enhance capabilities across diverse areas and to facilitate faster, defense-wide adoption of key technologies. Key collaboration partners in the program included ImpactUtah, CNP Technologies, ReliAscent, and the Oregon Manufacturing Extension Partnership. As Mentor, MSU-MilTech and their team provided extensive technical assistance, product and market research, and branding and marketing expertise in the areas of online collateral, tradeshow support, and government/military outreach. This included participation in the Air Force Tech Warrior Exercise, Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) Programs, and the Navy Transition Assistance Program (TAP). MSU-MilTech and CG Mentor Protégé efforts also included DCAA compliant accounting assistance, accounting software support, lean manufacturing, ISO-9001 quality management, design for manufacturing and assembly, supply chain assessment, NIST 800-171 cyber security compliance, and government procurement training.
